Praise God for the Cross and the Blood of Jesus! The Tomb in Empty. Let's rejoice!! May you have a glorious Easter celebrating the Resurrection of Jesus! He is ALIVE forevermore. Hallelujah!

Please remain in your car and proceed slowly around the Church Building. Please turn your vehicle around in the back parking lot and return to the front. Our "Stations" are now in the doors and windows of the Church. Please take your time, read the scriptures, pray and celebrate the Risen Savior at each station.

STATION 1 - JESUS AND THE DISCIPLES AT THE LAST SUPPER

Read John 13:3-15 "He poureth water into a basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which he was girded." Read Luke 22: 19-20 "And He took bread, and gave thanks, and broke it, and gave unto them, saying, this is my Body, broken for you; this do in remembrance of me."

STATION 2 - GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE

Read Matthew 26:42 "O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me except I drink it, thy will be done."

STATION 3 - JESUS IS CRUCIFIED ON THE CROSS

Read John 19: 17-18 "And Jesus, bearing his cross, went forth into a place called The place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew, Golgotha, Where they crucified him, and two others with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the center."

STATION 4 - SAYINGS OF JESUS ON THE CROSS

Read Luke 23:33-34 "Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots." Luke 23:43 "And Jesus said unto him, Today, shalt thou be with me in paradise." John 19: 26-27 "Woman, behold thy son! Behold thy mother." Mark 15:34 "My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?" John 19:28 "I thirst" John 19:30 "It is finished; and he bowed his head, and gave up the spirit" Luke 23:46 "Father, into thy hands I commend my Spirit,"
