This year: Community Christmas Day Meal from Noon -1:00 pm. Most of the food will be catered. A maximum of five people will work in the kitchen and fellowship, wear masks, use disposable gloves, and social distance. The food will be placed in take-out containers and an individual will place the tray on an outside table. Recipients of the food will drive around the Church and pick up the take-out tray(s). If weather permits, our picnic shelter tables will be set up and distanced. Families and individuals can enjoy a meal there. We will have a table with hand sanitizer, Lysol, masks, and gloves.
