### **JONESVILLE CAMPMEETING**

The 210th Annual Jonesville Camp Meeting has been cancelled for 2020. The first Camp Meeting was held in 1810. People camped on the grounds and at first worshipped under a brush arbor. In 1824 a permanent shed was built with split logs and still stands today as a memorial to those old Saints who worked hard and prayed for the people of the surrounding area. Camp Meeting has been held at this place since 1810 except two years in 1863 and 1864 when the War Between the States was on and Federal Troops had seized Cumberland Gap. The Camp Meeting was held at a Church four miles east of Jonesville. Now, history in 2020, Camp Meeting has been cancelled because of a pandemic and the servants of God will not gather this year. However, we can pray for the lost, sick, discouraged, and needy and believe for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit and the 210th Camp Meeting will still be alive!
