January Mission Project - UMCOR Hygiene Kits -The cost per kit is \$12.00 - \$15.00. The following is a list of items needed for the kits. One hand towel (15 x 25 –17 x 27 inches)-No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels, one washcloth, one comb-Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth. No pocket combs or picks. Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth. One toenail or fingernail clipper-No emery boards or metal nail files, one bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger)-No Ivory or Jergen’s soap, do not remove from packaging, one adult toothbrush-Do not remove from packaging. Personal advertising not acceptable. 10 adhesive bandages (¾ by 3 inches) Common household bandages acceptable, one one-gallon size re-sealable bag.
