Collect these items in a large (at least 17") backpack:
3 pks of loose-leaf, wide ruled paper OR 3 - 9 ¾" x 7.5" 100- sheet composition books (*No Spiral notebooks*), 1 Compass and 1 Protractor (may be packaged individually or as a set), 1 Ruler-12", 1 pack of Erasers, 1 (10-12 pack) of pencils, 1 small English Dictionary (*No thesauruses*), 1 (10-12 pack) of Black or Blue Pens, 1 Pack Coloring Pencils (*No crayons or markers*), 1 Ream (500 sheets) Copy Paper. The drop off deadline for your backpacks is May 23rd. If you prefer to give cash, the cost for one backpack is \$21.85. You may write a check to NUMC and give to Amy; she will be ordering the kits. As of today, we have 11 kits. Today is the deadline.

***Mission Offering** – This offering will be directed toward “Our South Sudanese Brothers and Sisters in Exile in Uganda Africa”. This will be received on May 15th.

***Change for Children** – This offering funds grants for Holston-related children's ministries for children in poverty and for children in South Africa. This offering will be received on May 22nd.
