Ash Wednesday –

The Lenten season of forty days begins this Wednesday, February 22nd and leads to Easter Sunday, April 9th. We will have a time after Bible Study of remembrance and preparing our hearts for this season. Ash Wednesday is named because of the ashes used to mark the foreheads of worshippers. The palm branches from the previous year's Palm Sunday Service are burned and used to apply the ashes in the form of a cross on the forehead of each worshipper. Please join us.
