**Report of the Holston Annual Conference – 2023 Called Special Session – Held April 22, 10 am – at Central UMC in Knoxville**

Following a time of worship and Holy Communion, a business session was called by Bishop Wallace-Padgett. The Disaffiliation Resolution was submitted and the vote was taken. All 264 churches submitted for disaffiliation (including Nottingham) were ratified. These churches will no longer be a part of the United Methodist Church as of May 29, 2023. As we all feel loss in this separation, some more deeply than others, and we grieve for this loss of our big church family, we trust God to heal our hurting hearts and renew and revive us once again. Pray for Nottingham as God opens hearts and opportunities for this church, community and the world.
