Ash Wednesday – We will be having a special service this Wednesday at 6 pm. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten season and is the official beginning of the forty days of Lent. It is so named because of the ashes used to mark the foreheads of worshippers. The palm branches from the previous year's Palm Sunday service are burned in a prescribed manner and the ashes are reserved for the next Ash Wednesday service. The Ash Wednesday service is a service of public penance. Worshippers are called forward to the altar rail, and the minister applies the ashes with his or her thumb to form the sign of the cross on the forehead of each worshiper. This is a public declaration of the need for repentance and prayer.
